Winemaker Notes: The 2017 vintage went through 100% malolactic fermentation which produced this lovely textured wine. Aromas of candied apple and lemon zest jump out of the glass. Flavors of crème brûlée and pears poached with baking spices come across on the palate which finishes clean due to the balanced acidity. The slight hint of toasty oak will compliment your favorite roasted chicken, pork or seafood dish.
