McNab Ridge's 2016 French Colombard pays tribute to wine pioneer John Parducci, who made his first French Colombard in 1945, and also to winegrower Bill Neimi, who spent decades farming choice grapes. The 2016 dry farmed, head pruned French Colombard grapes are grown in Neimi Vineyard by Alvin Tollini, Bill's grandson.
